Secretary's Report - Holt Mitchell - Approval of April Meeting Minutes – Minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report - Rich Harms – Finance Report – Around \$14,600 in the bank. Recent expenses include \$252 for newsletter and \$150 fee to submit Deermont petition.

Whispering Hills NPO- Officer Chad Briscoe– Recent Police Activity – School will be letting out in coming weeks, will likely see rise in loitering in area. Reminder to call 911 in any event you feel unsafe or see suspicious activity.

Special Guest –Parks Ambassador Bryan Kirk– Friendship Park
Many calls to police were received concerning Friendship Park. Security camera video from neighbors has been given to Parks Department. Parks Departement is stepping up enforcement in the park and cracking down on drug activity. If large groups, more than 50 people, are in park at any time or any suspicious activity, 911 can be called. Park hours are from 5am to 11pm.

New Efforts – Trap Neuter Release program for feral cats- Claudia Bankston

29 cats have been captured and spayed/neutered to date. Claudia made a request for \$300 from the TNR Donation Fund. The Board discussed and the Association can only reimburse from the TNR Fund provided receipts are given. Claudia Bankston stated receipts would be given to Treasurer Rich Harms, in which then Claudia would be reimbursed for sterilization fees Claudia paid out of pocket.
