Call to Order: 7:03 p.m.

Whispering Hills NPO- Officer Josh Cooper– Recent Police Activity – 4 murders in the northeast police area. 6 aggravated robberies in the area, however Whispering Hills is in good shape. In the northeast police subdivision there are 280 officers for 400,000 people. When gunfire call is received, the call is listed as a priority 4 in the police department’s response system.

Secretary's Report - Holt Mitchell - Approval of September Meeting Minutes – Minutes were approved as written. A discussion took place on the posting of meeting minutes; it was recommended by attendees that meeting minutes also be sent out through the email system.

Treasurer's Report - Rich Harms – Finance Report –Recent expenses include \$300 for six new VIP magnetic signs and \$252 for the newsletter. Concern about the cost of the current storage unit was brought up. David Blassingame offered to develop a list of storage places in the surrounding area and compare prices.

landscaping. Discussion on possible new stone border around existing landscaping at Whispering Hills and Walnut.

New Efforts- David Blassingame- Wall topper consideration- 4 blocks are without the topper (Rita, Morgan Meadow, Laingtree, and Branwood). 1 block has an estimated cost of \$1800. It was suggested that the association pay \$1 for \$1 donated. A donation form will be sent out in the coming newsletter. The Board approved getting a rough estimate for the masonry work.
